## Discover the Mystery of the Shroud of Turin

Join us for a captivating exploration of the Shroud of Turin with Deacon Paul as we delve into pivotal questions: Who is the man on the Shroud? How was his image transferred to this ancient burial cloth? Why do the bloodstains on the Shroud and the Sudarium of Oviedo (face cloth) match, yet only the Shroud bears a mysterious image?

Explore these and other intriguing aspects from the “Who is the Man on the Shroud?” exhibition, hosted by the Faith and Science Institute at the Pontifical Museum in Rose. This virtual video tour promises an enlightening experience with enlarged images, a life-size bronzed 3D sculpture, and replicas of the historical artifacts associated with the crucifixion, including the Roman flagrum (whip), crown of thorns, nails of crucifixion, and more.

### Father Rodney Farke

Birthday: August 2nd

Anniversary of Ordination: May 20, 1972

Home residence: Brookings, S.D.

After 2 years of studying engineering, Fr. Farke entered the seminary at St. Mary, Winona, Minnesota. He studied there for 3 years, then went to Catholic University of America in Washington, DC for Theology before ordination.

He served as an associate pastor at 2 parishes in Sioux Falls for 6 years. Then he served as pastor of the small parishes of Bristol and Lily, while helping at the Catholic High School in Aberdeen, S.D. He served as pastor at St. Martin in Huron, S.D. for 5 years, then at Immaculate Conception Parish, Watertown, SD for 7 1/2 years; at that location, he helped build a new church, remodeled the Catholic School, sold the rectory and remodeled the convent into a rectory, parish office, and meeting hall.

He was then sent to Yankton to establish the new parish of St. Benedict. He worked to build a church and hall, and rectory during his 11 1/2 years there. Next, he was sent to Vermillion, S.D., St. Anges Parish, where he served 4 years. During that time he help to build new parish offices and parish hall.

His last assignment was at St. Thomas More in Brookings, succeeding Fr. Mike Wensing. He served there for 8 years and retired in Brookings 8 1/2 years ago. He still helps out in that parish and other parishes in the area. His hobbies include bicycling, walking, hiking, playing at golf, reading, playing cards, and travelling. While vacationing in the Phoenix area, some S.D. friends who attend St. George, introduced him to Msgr. Pinti, suggesting that he may be a good helper here. He has been assisting here at St. George for 8 years now and we are very blessed to have him here!
