



St. Elizabeth of Portugal

The Brown Scapular of Our Lady of Mount Carmel

Our Lady of Mt. Carmel is the title given to the Blessed Virgin Mary in her role as the "Patroness of the Carmelite Order." The first Carmelites were Christian hermits (having a strong Marian devotion) living on Mt. Carmel in the Holy Land. On July 16, 1251, Our Lady appeared to Saint Simon Stock, a Carmelite and made the Scapular the sign of her protection.

The promotion of the Scapular & Consecration to Our Lady of Mt. Carmel will be at the 8:00 a.m. morning mass on Wednesday, July 16th.

St. Elizabeth of Portugal Feast Day: July 4th


Patron Saint of brides, widows, those falsely accused, difficult marriages, and charitable societies.

Elizabeth was born in 1271, the beautiful daughter of the King of Aragon. From the time she was a child, she lived an extraordinary life of prayer and devotion. At age 12, she married King Diniz of Portugal, an alliance her parents found beneficial, and the royal couple had two children.

A capable leader, Diniz Was loved by his people, but he was a weak, faithless husband. Still, Elizabeth treated him with respect and even agreed to educate his illegitimate children. But their son Alfonso was jealous of his father's fondness for his other offspring, and he rebelled. Even though Elizabeth intervened, their hostility festered until they confronted each other on a battlefield. Desperate to make peace, Elizabeth rode out between the two armies and persuaded them to reconcile.

An intelligent and caring woman, Elizabeth established orphanages, provided shelters for the homeless and founded a convent. She also built a hospital and cared for the sick. When her husband's health deteriorated, Elizabeth nursed him herself, never leaving his bedside.

Saddened by his death, Elizabeth joined the Third Order of St. Francis and retired to a small house near a convent and devoted herself to the poor and sick. Twelve years later, Alfonso, who was now king, began a campaign against the King of Castile over a personal dispute. Again, the elderly Elizabeth mounted her horse and followed the armies. She was successful in making peace, but this time, the attempt was too much for her. She became ill and died soon after. Her favorite words are with us today: "If you love peace, all will be well."


